

STUDENT HOMEWORK

The Board of Education recognizes homework as an integral part of each student's learning process and advocates staff's use of homework as a learning tool. Therefore, the Board of Education directs the staff and administration to establish school operating procedures on homework which recognize the importance of homework.

Administrative Regulations to Policy 6154  
Student Homework

Homework is any work outside the class including, but not limited to, a review of previous lessons, preparation for tests, organization of notes and other materials, and reading and writing assignments. In order to effect an educational continuity from day to day, each student will be assigned homework on the basis of the staff member's professional judgment. The amount of assigned homework will be determined by each teacher and stated in the course overview that each student will receive at the beginning of each course.

The actual amount of daily homework that a child receives will vary according to the requirements of the specific course and the need for an understanding of the classroom concepts being developed.
