INDOOR TRACK

Both boys and girls finished second as a team in their divisions. The girls missed winning by only 2 points. Over 85 schools were in attendance from Utah, Idaho, and Wyoming.

Jentry Skidmore won the long jump, took 2nd in the triple-jump, ran on two relays which took first and second. All four events were new school records.

The 4 x 400 meter relay were champions with a blazing time of 4:03. That mark broke the school record by 14 seconds! Team members: Gentry Skidmore, Kayla Rees, Kaitlin Smith, and Brittany Cardall.

The 4 x 200 relay also shattered the school record and just missed the state record. Relay members included Jentry Skidmore, Sarah Davies, Brittany Cardall, and Kaitlin Smith.
