## SANTA CUSE RESULTS

Syracuse High School did Santa Cuse this year. We had three focuses, for a three week time frame:

1. Giving Time
2. Giving Goods
3. Giving Riches
  1. Giving Time – We asked students, community, and surrounding schools to write letters to Santa Claus to donate to Macy's. For every letter written to Santa, Macy's will donate one dollar (up to one million dollars) to Make A Wish. We collected 30, 501 letters in just one week! We have meet with Macy's Region Manager and we have made regional news, and corporate news! We are the largest donation that they have ever received in the region.
  2. Giving Goods – We collected donations of food, clothing, and household goods, for the Lantern House in Ogden. We collected for 8 days. We filled over 4 bins full of items. We collected a total of 27 boxes of food. A pickup truck for of clothing, and lots of hygiene products. The Lantern House spotlighted us on their Facebook page.
  3. Giving Riches – Through parking lot collections, online donations, Titan wristbands, a hallway competition, and the Teacher Talent Assembly, we were able to raise \$3, 639.28 for the Christmas Box House in Ogden.
