

LEGAL REPRESENTATION

A decision to seek legal advice or assistance on behalf of the school district shall normally be made by the Board or Superintendent. Such action shall occur as it is consistent with approved district policy or standard practice and meets an obvious need of the District. It may also take place as a consequence of formal School Board direction.

Routine matters requiring legal assistance do not require specific Board approval or prior note. However, when the administration concludes that unusual types or amounts of professional legal service may be required, the Board directs the administration to so advise it and to expeditiously seek either initial or continuing authorization for such service.
