

STANDING COMMITTEES AND REPRESENTATIVES

Annually, the Regional School District No. 7 Board of Education shall establish standing committees to address the operations of the Board which may include committees on:

- Communications
- Policy

In addition the Board may appoint representatives to Shared Services, Education Connection (EdConn) and Connecticut Association of Boards of Education (CABE) from among its membership.

STANDING COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

The Chair of the Board of Education shall appoint or accept volunteers for each standing committee annually from among its members. Appointment to a standing committee or as a representative occurs at the Annual Organizational meeting. There shall not be more than four members to a standing committee. Any member of the board who is interested in serving on a standing committee or as a representative shall notify the Chair promptly concerning their interest.

All committees shall keep minutes of business conducted at meetings. The minutes will be kept on file in the Superintendent's office and available at all times to the Board of Education members.
