Meeting Topics

A. PLTW-Project Lead the Way

The District chose Oak Hills to implement PLTW next year, PLTW www.pltw.org:

- Blended learning method – project-based learning that has been around for 21 years.
 - Blended learning includes a variety of learning options with and without technology. Also includes:
 - a. Small group learning.
 - b. Flip classroom learning.
 - Project based learning. Models for each grade.
- ✓ . Grant to the Davis Education Foundation was awarded by Boeing Corp.
- ✓ Start next year. We are already doing this on some level already.
- ✓ The training for teachers will be paid for out of the grant.
- ✓ Resources – BOOKS about what advances student learning in schools:
 - John Hattie - Research on Learning
 - Weston Kieschnick - BOLD Schools
- ✓ Davis Education Foundation pays for \$15,000 and we have to provide \$5,000 of our own money for this project. Will the \$5000 need to come from Trustland money? Yes.

B. Reading Scores and Reading TA's

DIBELS-Reading Testing: The is just a snapshot of info to help us.

- Grades 1st-6th are tested, 3 times a year
- See Michelle's Presentation. (Email Michelle Daly for her presentation if interested.)

- 78 -81% went up from 2017-2018
- Helps to have more info to help the teachers direct TA's and adjust learning according to recent DIBELS scores.
- Yes, the scatter groups are working.
- TA's are worth the money and we would like to keep paying them using the Trustland money.
- How do we utilize the Take Home Reading Library more? Terra Lechtenberg is doing a great job with the library. Ideas needed. (Follow up item?)

c. There are a number of parent openings on the Advisory Committee. These openings were listed in the most recent newsletter. Three parents indicated an interest in serving on the committee. Erik Andersen will follow up with those parents and do some additional recruiting to fill these openings.
