Emergency Action Plan

Inglemoor Crew (Log Boom Park)

First Responder Tasks

1. Provide immediate care of the injured or ill

Other Personnel:

- 1. Retrieve necessary emergency equipment (see page 6)
- **2.** Call 911 and provide the following:
 - a. Your name
 - b. Location (city and state)
 - c. Phone number from which you're making the call
 - d. Number of injured/ill individuals
 - e. Condition of the injured/ill
 - f. Treatment being given
 - g. Directions to the site (see page 5)
 - **Do not hang up until the dispatcher tells you it is ok to do so.

3. Preparing for EMS arrival

1. Two individuals should "flag down" EMS in the parking lot of Log Boom Park and escort them to the emergency.


Venue Directions for EMS

Log Boom Park Pier

Address: 17415 61st Ave NE, Kenmore, WA 98028

From Bothell Way NE turn SOUTH on to 61st Ave NE; then immediately turn RIGHT (West) on NE 175 St. Enter through the gate of Log Boom Park. Take the lower trail past the facilities. An athlete will be located in the parking lot and by the facilities to direct EMS to the scene of the emergency.

**Do not hang up until the dispatcher tells you it is ok to do so.
