Course Description:

Led by the Chesapeake Bay Foundation, this program will take students to Bishops Head in Maryland's Blackwater National Wildlife Refuge to learn about the natural history and ecology of this remote area. Students research and experience the Bay first hand. Day trips on Wednesday and Thursday introduce students to the parameters by which Bay health is measured and the importance of forest in protecting the Bay. **Away overnight Sunday-Tuesday**
