Approval of March 20, 2017 minutes:

2. Community Council Elections:

3. Junior Achievement Biz Town and business partnerships:

- a. Biz town is an extra option through Junior Achievement but the cost is \$4500 for 5th grade only.
- b. There are 60 schools on the waiting list, but if you get a business to sponsor the school then you move up on the list.

4. Budget:

- a. Title 1 budget projections (unofficial) – Have rough numbers but everything is still up in the air.
- b. Class size projections – Still looking at numbers. Things are constantly changing.

5. Blended Learning Technology:
