2018-19 Highly Capable Program Eligibility Process for Families New to Northshore School District

Process for <b>Students with Current Highly Capable Designation</b> From a Previous School District	Process for <b>Students Seeking Highly Capable Designation,</b> Without a Previous Designation
<p>The Highly Capable Program eligibility process for high school students with a current Highly Capable designation from a previous school district involves a comprehensive file review and data analysis. Northshore School District requires comparable assessment data.</p> <p><b><u>Step 1: Submit Documentation to <a href="mailto:hicap@nsd.org">hicap@nsd.org</a></u></b> Submit documentation of Highly Capable status, including all available assessment data as soon as possible, <b>but no later than August 24, 2018.</b></p> <p>Documentation may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• CogAT or Naglieri (NNAT) (cognitive)</li><li>• Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) (academic)</li><li>• Torrance Test of Creative Thinking (TTCT) (creativity)</li><li>• Washington State Testing - Smarter Balanced</li><li>• District Assessments (transcripts, report cards, etc.)</li></ul> <p><b><u>Step 2: File Review/Analysis by District Team</u></b> A district team will convene the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> weeks of each month to review submitted materials, applying Northshore's eligibility criteria. Families will be notified of eligibility decision.</p>	<p>The Highly Capable Program eligibility process for high school students without a previous designation is an academic file review.</p> <p><b><u>Step 1: Request File Review to <a href="mailto:hicap@nsd.org">hicap@nsd.org</a></u></b> High School families seeking file review should contact the Highly Capable Department as soon as possible, <b>but no later than August 24, 2018,</b> to request an academic file review.</p> <p><b><u>Step 2: Submit Academic Data to <a href="mailto:hicap@nsd.org">hicap@nsd.org</a></u></b> Families should submit all recent and available academic data and information for review, including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Two years of report cards;</li><li>• State testing data;</li><li>• Transcripts; and</li><li>• Any other district level assessment data.</li></ul> <p><b><u>Step 3: File Review/Analysis by District Team</u></b> A district team will convene the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> weeks of each month to review submitted materials, applying Northshore's eligibility criteria. Families will be notified of eligibility decision.</p>
