**Analyze Data from Middle of Year DIBELS:**

Mid-year DIBELS was great! 73% of our students are at or above benchmark. 5% growth from the beginning of the year. Overall at or above typical progress is at 66%.

**Progress Report on SIP:**

49% overall growth in Language Arts, 61% overall growth in Math. We would like to see more growth in reading, writing, and science.

**2016-2017-** we met our goal of 73% proficiency in DIBELS. We have made more progress this year than last year in our “pathways to progress” through DIBELS.

Our attendance goal was 10% of students with 18 or less absences, our final percentage was 10.5%. We were so close!!

**2017-2018 Progress-** Our goal is to reach 77% proficiency, because we are at 73% we think our progress will continue to grow.
