SAGE Data- Stayed the same in Math. Science and Language Arts grew in proficiency.

PACE 3-6 Grade 22% minority, 11% ELL. School performance 394/600 compared to state 337/600. Achievement points- 160/300 compared to state 148/300. Growth points- 234/300 compared to state 191/300.

Met our DIBELS mid-year goal!

Attendance- AmeriCorps counselor, Parent Communication, Alarm Clocks, Attendance has improved from last year.

Math- Biggest concern, which was why math trainings were a main goal this year. Amy and Kayla are concerned about parent support when their students are struggling at home. Possible goal to help parents with math? District will help meet that need as they release videos on district page (dsd) as a resource. In a title 1 school, we need to have goals that fall under Literacy, Ready for Success at the Next Level, STEM, and Teaching for Learning. (Minimum of 2) Could consider a technology goal to upgrade iPads. Current iPads are the iPad 2 and the software cannot be further updated. iPad 4 air is the desired purchase. Possible Literacy goal-ELA Growth including DIBELS. Possibly RAZ Kids (reading A to Z) program for students. Possible STEM goal- learning and enrichment opportunities.
