Description:

We've been working on getting all our assignments entered and coded in My Open Math and then attach that to CANVAS. We've finished our first semester assignments and now we need to start working on our second semester assignments.

Value to Students:

Using My Open Math and then attaching those assignments to CANVAS is a way for all students to enter their assignment answers into a computer (or tablet or phone) and get immediate feedback as to whether they're doing them correctly or not.

If students are using our math lab, they can get immediate help from the teacher working in the math lab. If students have questions while at home working on CANVAS, they can come in for early morning or after school tutoring (from any of the Secondary Math III teachers) and get help for their CANVAS questions.

Getting immediate feedback on assignment questions is a great way to let students know that they understand the concepts or a way to get them to realize that they need some additional help to grasp the concepts.
