Dear Potential First Aid and Athletic Training Student and Parents/Guardians:

Through a partnership with Joliet Junior College (JJC), Joliet Township High School students have an opportunity to take KIN 207-208 while still in high school and upon successful completion of these courses, earn both college and high school credit simultaneously. Students wishing to enroll in these dual credit classes must

- Successfully complete three years of physical education.
- Complete the Academic Dual Credit Student Approval Form.
- Complete the application for admission to Joliet Junior College
- Contact the college or university they plan to attend regarding approval of transfer credit.
- Check NCAA eligibility status if applicable.
- Meet with their counselor to enroll in the class with all required paperwork completed by **April 3**, **2018**.
- Attain building Principal's approval to leave campus.

The following is general information about the dual credit opportunity for Joliet Township High School students:


- KIN 207-208 will be taught on campus at JJC on Tuesday and Thursday from 1:00 p.m. until 2:20 p.m.
- Students will be released from the high school campus at 12:20 p.m. each day.
- Transportation to and from JJC will be the responsibility of the student and parents/guardians.
- Tuition and fees will be the responsibility of the student and parents/guardians.
- Costs of textbooks and other required materials will be the responsibility of the student and parents/guardians.
- JJC courses are semester courses, students will receive two college credit hours for KIN 207 in the fall and three college credit hours for KIN 208 in the spring. Upon successful completion of these two semesters, students will have earned five hours of college credit and will have earned 1 hour of high school physical education credit.
- Students who have earned a "D" or an "F" in any JJC class prior to this point in time may NOT register for another dual credit course. Students who successfully pass KIN 207 but receive a "D" or an "F" in any other JJC course taken concurrently with the KIN 207 class will not be allowed to register for KIN 208.
- Students successfully completing KIN 207-208 will have a JJC transcript on file at the college indicating their grades and credits awarded.
