# Three College Courses – 10 Total Credits

- Fall Semester:
  - **FSCI 101 – Principles of Emergency Services (3 college credits)**
    - August 21 – October 12, 2017
  - **FSCI 102 – Introduction to Fire Prevention (3 college credits)**
    - October 16 – December 14, 2017
- Spring Semester:
  - **EMS 101 – First Responder (4 college credits)**
- 2 Total High School Credits, 1 High School Credit per semester

# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



- No cost to the student
- JJC provides facilities, equipment and instructors for the program
- JJC will also cover the cost of textbooks for all three courses
- JTHS will cover the cost of tuition and fees (Approximately \$ 1,440.00 per student) for the 2017-18 school year.

- Classes held on JJC main campus  
**Monday – Thursday**  
**1:15 p.m. – 2:45 p.m.**
- Students will attend high school courses **Periods 2 – 5.**
- Students follow the JJC calendar including holidays and spring break.



# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



## SIP days

- Students will not attend JJC class on SIP A days
  - (9/7, 10/5, 11/2, 12/7, 2/8, 3/8, 4/19)
  - Periods 1, 4, 3, 2
- Students **will attend** both JT and JJC on SIP B days
  - Periods 5, 6, 7, 8

Class size will be 8-12 students (Cohort of JTHS Students only)

# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



- Students are responsible for their own daily transportation to and from class.

# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



- If dropped from the JJC courses, students will either have a non-punitive “W” (withdrawn) or an “F” on their official college transcript.
- If withdrawn from the Program, the student will be scheduled into study halls at JTHS.



# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



**Upon successful completion of the Fire Science – EMS Cohort program, students will have multiple options:**



- Enroll in the JJC Fire Science Technology Program
  - Associate in Applied Science (AAS)
  - Fire Science Internship Program
- Enroll in the Emergency Medical Services Program
  - Associate in Applied Science (AAS)
- Internship - Paramedic Program
- Internship - EMT Certificate Program



# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



- JTHS Parent Approval Forms must be submitted by May 24, 2017.
- The online JJC Dual Credit application must be completed no later than May 24, 2017.

# JJC Fire Science / Emergency Medical Services



- Student selection is based on the following:
  - Teacher/Counselor Recommendation
  - CTE Courses Completed
  - Grades/GPA
  - Attendance
  - Responses on JTHS Fire Science-EMS Program Applications
  - Face to Face Interviews
