Kim and Lori will work at gathering feedback from the teachers on how the tutors are working for the classes and with what results, as well as ask for any other needs they have that will affect how we use the LAND trusts monies for next year. They will start polling the teachers in January.

Testing Data and LAND Trust expenditure review:

In November, Don & Tiffany will bring the data for how our students are doing in performance and growth and Title 1 focuses.

Monitoring visit: A group from the Federal programs department. They interview parents, go in every classroom, review books. They have about 27 points to review as they monitor. They review data, how we're using PLC's, how teachers are identifying children in need and what we're using Title 1 budget on. Antelope had 0 findings and 4 commendations.

There will be another monitoring visit by the state in January.

Antelope has been designated as a reward school. Don has the certificate and will be getting it framed for the office.

Bond:

Don had a stack of papers that the district wanted parents to sign if they supported the bond and wouldn't mind having their name posted in support of the bond.
