SIP and differentiated instruction (add in science):

The discussion centered around adding a science factor to the SIP for next year Mr. Villar is going to check with another school to see if we can borrow their Science Standards booklets for the remainder of this year. There are new standards coming out next year that will roll out to the 4th grade students and then be tracked as those students move up through the next grades.

It was agreed to add a science goal on the SIP, for next year. We will be adopting the new curriculum for next year and expanding on focus to our science curriculum and terminology next year. By putting the goal into the SIP plan it holds us accountable to make sure we are offering help and support to the teachers in implementing these items to reach the SIP goal.

The new booklets could be paid for (\$2,600 - \$3,600) out of the Title 1 funds or the Text Book line items from the school budget.

Other Topics:

Painted crosswalk in the new parking lot has been requested. We are just waiting for the district to approve the work. There was a new railing put in today.

When the Huntsman Award comes through to the school, as a community council we should support teachers being nominated and help get reference letters from students and parents.

If there are any projects or help needed the LDS church just put up a new volunteer website called justserve.org, so if there are projects that teachers or the school needs, we could utilize this resource for getting volunteers to come in and complete the work.
