

MKA MIDDLE SCHOOL DRESS CODE

Regular Dress Code (Revised):

- Corduroy, khaki style, solid color dress pants, shorts or skirts; these bottoms should neither be overly loose nor overly tight fitting, and skirts/shorts need to be near the knee
- Collared shirt (polo, oxford style, turtleneck, MKA Rugby shirt)
- Sneakers, boots, closed-toe shoes
- Students may wear solid-color sweaters or MKA sweatshirts OVER collared shirts
- Tie is optional
- No jeans, sweatpants, yoga pants, gym shorts

Spirit Fridays:

- Students may wear dress code bottoms or jeans
- MKA tops (must be visible)
- No non-MKA sweatshirts
- OR Regular Dress Code

Concert Band and Chorus Dress Code:

- Black pants or skirt (skirt must be to fingertip with arm extended to side)
- White dress shirt with sleeves
- Black dress shoes
- Tie

Dress Down Days:

- *Bottoms:*
- Shorts and skirts that are mid-thigh
- Pants
- Sweatpants
- *Tops:*
- Collared shirts
- T-shirts
- Sweatshirts
- *NOT Allowed:*
- Excessively short shorts
- Torn or ripped clothing
- Leggings
- Tank tops
- Bare midriff
- Inappropriate writing

General Restrictions:

- Earrings are the only acceptable body piercing
- No visible tattoos
- No leggings (unless under skirts)

- No ripped or torn clothing
- No logos larger than a quarter
- No writing on clothing
- No hats
- No sleeveless shirts
- No bare midriffs
- No excessively tight- or loose-fitting clothing
- No flip-flops or open-toed shoes
- No pajamas

Spirit Fridays, Concert Band and Chorus Dress Code, Dress Down Days and General Restrictions have not changed.
