- Sage Testing Results: Antelope score was a B. Principal Beatty covered the Utah Education PACE (Prepare, Access, Complete, Economic Success) report card. The scorecard is on the state education web site and parents can access it there. Parents are welcome to come in to the office and discuss these results with Mr. Beatty.
