Minutes: Motion to approve the minutes from our last meeting by Jenny Pitt, Cindy Jenkins seconded the motion

PTA Report by Stacy Macauley: Earning for learning at Harmons went well; next week is Teacher Appreciation Week; PTA wants to set up Math Nights for next year-- Mr.Hughes supports this decision

School Improvement Plan Approval: Funds allocated for year: \$36,267.00
We reviewed the 2016/2017 SIP goals and funds that will be allocated toward our goals. The first three goals are from the district and the last two goals are from our school.

DISTRICT GOAL #1 (Student Achievement): Funds allocated for this goal: \$9,000.00

Increase the percentage of K-3 students scoring at or above DIBELS middle-of-year composite score benchmark from 83% in 2016 to 84% in 2017 (1% increase or approximately 5 students.)

Measures to determine progress/successful completion of the goal:

 Middle-of-year DIBELS composite scores.

Action Plan: Substitutes will be provided for teachers to do DIBELS testing. An intervention aide will be hired to support teachers for 10.5 hours per week.

DISTRICT GOAL #2 (College, Career, and Community Readiness): \$500.00

Reduce the percentage of students who are chronically absent (10% or more days with unexcused absences) from 4% to 2% (2% reduction or approximately 12 students.)

Measures to determine progress/successful completion of the goal:

 Chronic absenteeism report.

Action Plan: Provide an incentive program to reward students for on time and attendance throughout the year.

DISTRICT GOAL #3 (Quality Staffing):

Measures to determine progress/successful completion of the goal:

Evaluate Davis system data.

Action Plan: All staff members will self-assess and set goals. 100% of observations will be completed for those staff members that require observations. Summative evaluations will be conducted for all staff members.

SCHOOL GOAL #4: Teaching staff will participate in the USOE sponsored Assessment to Achievement project. Funding: \$10,200.00

Measures to determine progress/successful completion of the goal: Sage formative, interim and summative testing as well as CRT interim and year end testing.

Action Plan: Learner centered problems in ELA and Math will be identified through data collection. Evidence based instructional strategies will be used to impact student learning. Collaborative Teaching Teams will meet weekly to plan, collaborate, examine data, and create common assessments. Professional development will support their efforts. Teachers will hold Math Literacy nights for parents to explain new math strategies and how they can assist their child.

SCHOOL GOAL #5: All teachers will have upgraded computers/projectors/lpads and TVs. Funding: \$16,000.00

Measures to determine progress/successful completion of the goal: Inventory will be kept on all computers to insure that teachers have the capability to access all software and internet servers.

Action Plan: Teachers will use technology to instruct students, test students, assess students, create common assessments and to create lesson plans.

We talked about incentives for teachers to go to the coding class which is free but is on a Saturday. We will discuss this with Mr. Hughes in the future.

We talked about the STEM Program and the need we have for a new teacher to lead it.

Motion to approve the SIP plan was made by Cindy Jenkins, Mrs. Connors seconded the motion and we all unanimously agreed. We signed the paper verifying that we all participated in the process of creating our school SIP for 2016-2017.
