Approval of last meeting's minutes: The minutes were amended to show that Jim Bachelor was present.

Title 1 school Board visit: It was a good visit, the board liked what they saw.

Financial Update: A tracker was finally hired yesterday (March 13th). Because it took so long to find a tracker (Americorp employee fell through) and because of lower stipends, we'll have a \$16 000 budget carry over.

Academic Update: No data yet. Term is almost over.

School improvement plan goals discussion:

Goal #1: 50th percentile in growth scores in language arts. Summer stipends for teachers to meet with their PLC's twice (up to 2X\$100) and for a completed "assignment" (\$100)

Goal #2: 50th percentile in Growth score for both Math & Science

Goal #3: Attendance. (Tracker position) Will not meet this goal this year. As of this week, we had about 15% of students chronically absent. The after-school program is helping to remedy that. More professional developments especially on poverty and trauma.

Goal #4: On track for graduation (credits)

Counseling Department: Great incoming 7th Grader's night! 3 Elementary feeder schools tied with 75% attendance! (Wasatch, Holt and South Clearfield)

Course registrations are in, starting to build the master schedule.

Working hard on credit recovery for 9th graders.

After-School Program: Little Mermaid is coming up. Numbers have increased a bit.
