- Shauna- review UDOT plans
 - 14 major hazard points
 - Safe routes to school is open until end of September. City has to apply school can't
 - Work with Andy and up to \$200,000 available
 - Can be used for infrastructure
 - Look for items on plan that we can get it started
 - Need to get city to write application
 - Impact fee from developers – Kaysville doesn't have it
 - South side of 200 north will be bike path
 - David Roberts- call about buses – 801-402-7540
 - Met with Julie, drove around. District initiated hazardous bus study by independent consulting firm. Hopefully done before school starts. Interim superintendent also wants done quickly. Not counting kids on the road – using map with where kids walk.
 - District is aware of problem. Consulting firm will make recommendation. One bus will still come to school.
 - Go to city planning department to find out agreement with Destination Homes and sidewalks.
 - Shauna will meet with Andy in the next week – money for safe routes to school. Probably not available until next summer.
 - If there's a hazardous crossing – 15 kids crossing – UDOT has special funds in traffic and safety to put in crosswalk, guard, lights

- Teachers will provide resources to help parents be able to help their children
- Khan Academy

- Innovation will teach our children to be leaders
