**Approval of last meeting's minutes:** Reviewed and unanimously approved

**Financial Update:** Land Trusts: On track to spend all of the money on SIP goals and approved expenditures.

**Academic Update:** Tyler Poll

- 3<sup>rd</sup> term Data review: Presented F's by term and Average GPA by term summaries. Highest 3<sup>rd</sup> term GPA in the last several years.
- School Improvement Plan: District "Learning First" planning day is 4/18. They will review the goals the district wants each school to have and put the plan together based on our discussions of importance, focus and money allotted for Land Trust funds. Council members will need to come in and sign the LandTrust SIP district sheet. It will be in the office and must be signed before May 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Some of the goals we will need in the SIP will be regarding our teacher PLC's. Our teachers currently meet 3 x's month. A goal could be written for singleton teachers to meet quarterly with other teachers in the district that cover the same subjects and identify areas to improve implementation of different teaching opportunities. Because we are one of only a few schools in the district already doing PLC's and our teachers are receiving high marks for their implementation of teaching strategies in the classroom, we would state in the goals that we want our teachers to maintain their excellence.

**Counseling Department Items:**

- Credit recovery: Doing well. Working with students who have I's or are credit deficient from 3<sup>rd</sup> term to get as many as possible, credit for the term. Our goal is to have no more than 30 9<sup>th</sup> grade students that are credit deficient towards graduation.

**After School Program:**
