We can also encourage teachers to take advantage of the Davis Foundation grants that are up to \$500.00/each teacher. There is also Donors Choose, that has \$750,000 dollars available.

Academic Update:

The SIP goals: Improving writing scores as measured by SAGE sub scores, decreasing the number of 9th graders moving on with deficient credit and promote higher order thinking classes that are more rigorous for the students.

Staff Measures: Reducing F's, tracked by week.

Increase number of students taking rigorous classes in each content area.

We can review SAGE results on the state website. We will review this data at our October meeting.

Counseling Department Items:

GEAR UP: is taking 8th graders to Jr. Achievement City and a University Tour for September 30th and October 7th from 7:30 – 3:30. They are looking for chaperones to volunteer to come and spend the day with the students as

they participate in these activities. Chaperones will need to provide their own lunch. First 200 kids go to Reality Town and the rest of the students will go on the college tour.
