DRESS CODE

The Garland ISD school board has approved standardized dress for all Brandenburg students. Standardized dress is made up of clothing that meets a particular description but is not a specific brand of clothing. The dress and grooming codes outlined below are not optional. Students will be given disciplinary consequences if they do not follow the dress and grooming codes. Please take the dress code with you when shopping for school clothing. Stores advertising school uniforms or standardized dress may not meet our dress code requirements.

SHIRTS:

- Solid red, white, or navy TRADITIONAL polo-style knit shirts with collar and a maximum of 4 buttons.
- NO logos or brand names visible.
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- A solid white undershirt may be worn underneath polo. No other color of undershirts are permissible.

PANTS:

- Navy or khaki TRADITIONAL style with finished hem
- NO jeans, cargo (any pockets on the legs), jogger style (gathered at the ankle), or leggings are permitted.
- Belt must be worn.

SHORTS/SKIRTS:

- Navy or khaki loose fitting traditional style.
- Two inches above the knee or longer with a finished hem.
- No cargo shorts are permitted.
- No leggings may be worn.
- Skirts only may be red/blue plaid.

SWEATSHIRTS/SWEATERS:

- Solid navy, red, white, or gray pull-over or cardigan style.
- Must be worn over a polo shirt.
- NO HOODS are permitted.

JACKETS:

- NO HOODS are permitted.
- Lightweight red, navy, white, or gray.
- NO visible logos or brand insignias.
- Heavy coats or jackets may not be worn to class. They can be kept in the lockers.

SHOES:

- Tennis shoes, loafers, dress shoes, or other closed shoes.
- No sandals, flip flops, house shoes, cleats, wheeled shoes, etc.

BELTS:

- Traditional style with buckle required for pants/shorts/skirts with belt loops.

SPIRIT DRESS: Fridays and other special days as designated by administration.

- Traditional jeans- Blue or black. NO designs, holes, rips, or tears.
- School spirit shirt only. No polo shirts with jeans.

JEWELRY:

- Male students may not wear earrings.
- Facial and body piercing of any kind is prohibited.
- No jewelry that causes a distraction or that could be dangerous to the student or other individuals (spiked, studded, choker, chain links, etc.)

HATS AND HEAD COVERINGS:

- Student may not wear rollers, hair picks, combs, or brushes in their hair.
- Hats, caps, bandanas, sweat bands, hoods, visors, or other nonreligious head coverings should not be worn.

HAIR AND GROOMING:

- Hair, including facial hair, must be cleaned, groomed, and by the nature of the style does not intend to create a distraction.
- Inappropriate hair designs/insignias are prohibited.
- Hair color that is disruptive or distractive to the school environment is prohibited. Hair must either be a NATURAL color or naturally tinted or colored in a blended and balanced manner.
- Hair must be kept out of the eyes and must not be a distraction.

The final decision in determining appropriate dress and appearance shall rest with campus administrators.
