The Trustlands school improvement plan needed to be adjusted from our last meeting. The amount budgeted for aides did not include a cost of living raise, so the library book money for that. But the PTA is going to be giving \$2,000 to the library for books, money they made from the book fair.

Goal #1 (student achievement) the percentage is set by the district. Our goal was 77%, we did not achieve that this year as we only reached 67%. This year the goal will be 71%.
