Registration Fee

Registration Fee €50

Registration fee is payable at time of application by cheque or bank transfer and is non-refundable.

Deposit

Deposit €2,000

Deposit is payable once a place is offered. The deposit is allowable against the final account at the end of 6th year. Note that the deposit is **not refundable** should a place be accepted and then the student subsequently not attend the school. Deposit is **not refundable** if a student is withdrawn from school or leaves for any reason before the completion of 6th year. Deposit payable by cheque or bank transfer.

Live In

Live In €250

This fee is applicable to students applying for 1st Year and who attend the Live In to experience life in the school.

Methods of Payment

Method 1 - Full Payment

By **Cheque** for Total Amount payable by **1st August 2018** or
By **Bank Transfer** for Total Amount payable by **1st August 2018**

Note that Method 1 - Full Payment is required for all Non-EU residents.

Method 2 - Two Payments

By **Two Cheques** to be received by **1st August 2018**, Each for 50% of Total, one cheque being a post-dated cheque (Dated 1st December 2018) or

Bank Transfer for 50% of Total Amount payable by **1st August 2018** and
Bank Transfer for 50% of Total Amount payable by **31st December 2018**.

Method 3 - Standing Order

By eight Standing Order payments from **August 2018** to **March 2019** of:

7 Day Boarder	€2,412.50 x 8 SOs (for first boy) €2,171.25 x 8 SOs (for subsequent brothers)
Day	€1,443.75 x 8 SOs (for first boy) €1,299.38 x 8 SOs (for subsequent brothers)

Note that the Standing Orders need to be increased by €81.25 per month to cover TY Levy.

Standing Orders need to be set up directly with your bank.

Please note that we do not offer a Direct Debit option.

Method 4 - PaytoStudy - online payment option for international students

We have partnered with PaytoStudy to facilitate international payments without paying international banking charges while receiving competitive foreign exchange rates.

EU residents can pay via PaytoStudy. 50% of Total Amount payable by **1st August 2018** and 50% of Total Amount payable by **31st December 2018**.

Non-EU residents can pay via PaytoStudy. Full Amount payable by **1st August 2018** .

Expenses

Note that invoices will be issued for any expenses incurred by pupils in January 2019 (in respect of expenses incurred in the period Sept to Dec 2018) and June 2019 (in respect of expenses incurred in the period Jan to June 2019).

Expenses include non-timetable subjects, grinds, extra text books, educational software, exam fees, Day Boarder bus, medical bills, prescription charges, music, tennis, golf, speech, taxis and activities. You will have the option at the beginning of the school year of signing up your son for music, public speaking or optional sports lessons.

There is no remission or discount if a student withdraws from music or optional sports after September because the school employs tutors and coaches based on the committed numbers at the end of September.

The cost of optional domestic or overseas trips organised by the school will be added to the student's expense account (e.g. ski trip).

Extra subjects With the exception of Art, REx and Latin, any arrangements for the delivery of subjects outside the normal school timetable (additional to or instead of what can be accommodated on the timetable) will be charged to the Parent/Guardian and is additional to our standard fees.

The timing and cost needs to be agreed in advance with the Principal. Please be aware that taking an extra subject outside of timetable is expensive (circa €50 per hour or higher depending on teacher).

Grinds It is a School policy requirement that any Grinds provided at Glenstal must be delivered by Glenstal teachers. Requests for the provision of grinds must be submitted to the Principal. Grinds are charged at €48 per hour and added to your expenses account. Parents must not pay teachers directly.

Sports lessons Parents will be notified of the charges for any optional extra sports such as tennis, fencing, golf or rowing at point of sign-up. We typically try to provide extra sports at €10 per hour but this depends upon numbers participating and the level of coaching expertise.

Music lessons €25 per half hour lesson, typically 15 lessons in Winter term and 16 lessons in Spring/Summer term. Annual cost = €775

Public speaking €10 per hour, typically 13 lessons in Winter term and 13 lessons in Spring/Summer term. Annual cost = €260

Laundry

There is no charge for Sports laundry.

Personal laundry is charged based on weight:

Day Boarder Bus

A day boarder bus service will be provided on routes if there is sufficient demand to make the operation of the route economic. A Glenstal bus service is typically provided from Nenagh to Glenstal. A parent organised bus service has previously operated on the Adare to Glenstal route.

We will survey parents in the summer to determine if there is sufficient demand for each route. Cost will then be advised when we have an indication of the numbers wanting to avail of the service. There is no remission in circumstances where a student has been signed up for the bus service but does not travel on certain days. The bus cost will be added to the expense account of each student.

Day Boarder Overnight Stays

Bed and Breakfast (and bed linen) €30.00 per night

(The day boarder fee includes 10 overnight stays and the above charge is for any additional nights)

Overseas Students

Overseas students typically require additional support and services including travel and administration assistance, book rental and bed linen. These extra services are included in the EU and Non-EU Boarding Fees.

EU designation is based on the place of residence of both parents.

Non-EU designation is based on the place of residence of both parents.

Please note that we require fees for Non-EU to be fully paid in advance.

English language lessons are provided for an additional cost of €50 per lesson. The school will determine whether English lessons are required and where English is not the first language lessons will normally be necessary. We will typically deliver up to 25 lessons during the academic year (€50 x 25 = €1,250).

Other

Expenses are immediately payable upon receipt of the expense invoice/statement and may be paid by cheque or bank transfer or PaytoStudy.

Glenstal Abbey School - Financial Terms & Conditions

The Parent/Guardian undertakes to pay in full all Fees and Expenses in respect of the Student which are incurred while the Student attends Glenstal Abbey School. All Fees and Expenses must be paid on or before the specified payment date.

The signatory (signatories) on the student's registration form accepts responsibility for all monies due. Liability is joint and several for two signatories.

A deposit is payable when an offer of a place in the School has been accepted. The deposit is not refundable if the student does not take up a place at the School or if the student leaves the school before the completion of 6th year,

Fee accounts must be kept up to date in order to secure the student's place in the school.

There is no remission on fees for absences (e.g. ill-health or other).

There is no remission on fees for unexpected School closures outside of the control of the Board of Management.

A term's notice must be given in writing when a student is being withdrawn from School. If the required notice is not received, a full term fees are payable. Deposits are not refundable where a student is withdrawn or expelled from school.

The School prioritises full boarding applicants to maintain the 7-day boarding characteristic and 7-day operation of the school. A specified number of Day Boarders are accepted in each year group (particularly in the junior years) but are expected to transition to Full Boarding to fully benefit from the Glenstal Abbey School education. It is not permissible to transfer from Boarding to Day Boarding.

Interest will be charged on overdue accounts.

The School will charge the Parent/Guardian for the full replacement cost of any items of property damaged or broken by the student, including the cost of labour regardless of whether that labour is supplied by employees of the school or supplied by external professionals.

Any failure or delay by the school in enforcing or partially enforcing its rights under these Terms & Conditions shall not be constituted as a waiver of any of its rights hereunder.

Nothing in these Terms & Conditions affects the statutory rights of the Parent/Guardian.

These Terms & Conditions are governed by the laws of Ireland and the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the Irish courts.

The School reserves the right to make reasonable changes to these Terms & Conditions from time to time. Terms and Conditions last revised 08 June 2018.
