- Selection of
 - Chair (Rebekah Richards)
 - Vice Chair (Paulynn Hacking)
 - Secretary (Jessica Gibbons)
- 2016-2017 goals
 - Davis Collaborative Teams; Transition from PLC to DTC groups; staff development 75% of the time, subs paid for by land trust funds; single departments will meet with cone group quarterly
 - One Note used to track progress
- School Recognition Programs
 - Recognize teachers with “department of the month”
 - Term High Honor Roll, Honor Roll, Most Improved awards, “No Tardy Party”
- Credit Recovery
 - Less than 10% of 9th grade students moving on to high school credit deficient
 - Continue with all current credit recovery programs
 - Change end of term class to Saturday school program
 - Establish mentor program within administration and counseling department
- Language Arts, increase SAGE proficiency score from 51% to 55%
 - Working on school wide reading program
 - Use practice tests
 - Take English tests last
 - Target students with a “2” on the proficiency test
- Review of land trust monies from last year
 - Computer lab (well used, would like a second lab)
 - SRC program (two persons to administer, 3.9 hours a day x 5 days a week)
 - Math aid
 - English (reading) aid

Amendment B (if we support it) is related to trustlands growth; currently the interest and dividends earned on trustlands funds can be allocated for schools. If the wording is changed (ie amendment B) we can receive up to 4% of the fund earned for school
