



In an effort to support academic performance, the Saint Thomas Academy Admissions Committee carefully reviews the requested admission materials and entrance exams of each student.

Each year, a number of students are accepted on supervision, so please do not be discouraged or overly concerned. We know some students need additional support to thrive in a college preparatory environment. Therefore, we have a team in place to provide students with supervision so that at every opportunity they may have success. The supervision protocol is designed to provide a safety net for academic achievements.

At Saint Thomas Academy, we will work together as a team – student, parents, teachers, counselors and staff members. The supervision recommendations may differ for each student however the basics are:

1. The student accepted on supervision is expected to maintain a minimum GPA each quarter with his assigned counselor monitoring and supporting his progress.
2. Our counselors and learning specialists will monitor his student planner and grades.
3. Students who **do not** have a diagnosed learning difference will work with a counselor who will monitor academic progress and meet with him regularly to update the student planner and discuss tutoring schedules.
4. Students who do have a diagnosed learning difference will work with our Learning Specialists. We do require full disclosure and all current assessment reports (within the last three years) to provide classroom accommodation.
