## PROGRESS REPORTS

Progress needs to be reported for every student receiving Special Education services in grades K-12 on each student's **specific IEP goals** at the end of each term. Preschool and Post-High report progress twice a year. When reporting progress for move-in students, if goals have not been entered in the Move-In button in myIDEA, you must use the alternative progress report in fillable forms. You must report progress before writing a new IEP as the goals from the previous IEP will no longer be available. Remember to print two copies, one for parent and one for the file and <u>finalize</u>! The final progress report option is not mandatory, but is a great tool for IEP meetings.

<u>FYI</u>: On the main screen of myIDEA under Reports>Progress Listing, you can print ALL students' progress at the same time.



## TRANSFERRING STUDENTS

Just a reminder that any IEP or Eligibility Determination due BEFORE OCTOBER 31<sup>st</sup>, 2013 for Preschool to Kinder, 6<sup>th</sup> grade,9<sup>th</sup> grade and 12th grade students transferring to post-high school programs need to be held BEFORE the end of the 2012-2013 school year. This is **NOT OPTIONAL**; it is a Special Education Department policy. Please refer to the following transition link for appropriate steps:
