In close collaboration with French Mathematics teachers, examples of topics to be covered are:

- Operations with rational numbers
 - Draw construct and describe triangles
 - Use properties of operations to generate equivalent expressions
 - Solve real-life and math problems using numerical and algebraic expressions and equations
 - Problem solving involving angles
 - Add, subtract, multiply and divide rational numbers
 - Draw, construct and describe geometrical figures and describe relationships between them
 - Exponents and problems involving scientific notation
 - Solve real-life and math problems involving surface area
 - Ratios and proportional relationships through problems
 - Equations and problems from AMC8
 - Solve real-life and math problems involving volumes
 - Use random sampling to draw inferences about a population Draw informal comparative inferences about two populations Investigate processes and develop, use, and evaluate probability models.
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- Grade 6 math (1 hour per week per class x 2 classes)
 - Grade 7 math (1 hour per week per class x 2 classes)
 - Grade 8 math (1 hour per week per class x 2 classes)
