Increase the percentage of K-3 students scoring at or above DIBELS middle-of-year composite score benchmark from 55% in 2016 to 62% in 2017 (7% increase or approximately 18 students.)

Reduce the percentage of students who are chronically absent (10% or more days with unexcused absences) from 11% to 9% (2% reduction or approximately 10 students.)

1. There have been 22% more absences when comparing 15-16 school year versus 16-17 school year
2. There are approximately 12 families who have taken students out of school for out of town visits who's is impacting attendance rates.

Teachers will ensure through high quality instruction and differentiation that all students will have the opportunity to learn and progress.

Increase or maintain student achievement for All students. In addition we will increase the percentage of students scoring at or above grade level on the end-of-year Math Assessment by 3% for all grade levels.

Attendance Data – Midyear Look – We are up 300 from this point last year.

As I am taking a midyear look at attendance data, we currently have 22% more absences right now that we did last year at this same time. Additionally, we have 18% more tardies right now that we did last year at this same time
