- Administering and reporting academic assessments with the proficiency levels students are expected to meet.

**Wasatch Elementary will provide materials and training to help parents work with their children by:**

- Scheduling activities to provide information on curriculum, programs, expectations, school rules, etc.),
- Conducting teacher taught family nights throughout the school year,
- Sending information and current events home in a monthly newsletter, and
- Setting up educational links by teachers/ school on web pages.

**Wasatch Elementary will educate teachers and staff on effective ways to communicate and reach out to parents by:**

- Implementing and coordinating parent programs that build ties between parents and the school,
- Encouraging teachers to work closely with the Parent Teacher Association (PTA), and Community Council, and
- Providing training during faculty meetings.

**Wasatch Elementary will coordinate with Head Start, other preschool programs, and parent resource centers to involve parents in the education of their children by:**

- Providing information on programs and resource at Parent Information Resource Center (PIRC), etc.,
- Organizing a yearly Kindergarten Round-Up, and
- Planning with the Community Center and Head Start to organize events to involve parents throughout the year.

**Wasatch Elementary will ensure that information related to school programs, meetings, and activities is sent home in a format and, to the extent practicable, language the parents can understand by:**

- Translating key documents and posting such documents on the school website,
- Sending information home in both English and Spanish (other languages upon request if available), and
- Providing Translators upon request for meetings with teachers, administrators, etc.

**Wasatch Elementary will provide reasonable access to parents by:**

- Scheduling Individual Learning Plan (ILP) conferences and providing parents opportunities to communicate with administrators and teachers by way of written notes, email, phone calls, etc., and
- Creating guidelines and opportunities for parents to volunteer and observe in the classroom.

- Opportunities sponsored through the PTA before or after school.

- Working with Wasatch Community Learning Center for parenting classes, ESL classes, job search information, etc.
