## **ROCORI Community Ed. Kid Care Common Questions and Answers:**

### **1) What are Kid Care's hours?**

A: ROCORI Kid Care is open at the ROCORI District Education Facility, 527 Main Street, Cold Spring, MN 6:30a.m. - 5:30p.m. Please do not drop your child(ren) off before 6:30a.m., or pick your child(ren) up after 6:00p.m. Students dropped off before 6:30 a.m. will not be let into the class room, and students picked up after 5:30p.m. will result in a late pick up fee. In order for us to ensure the safety of the students, you MUST come in to check your child(ren) in and out. They may not do it themselves.

### **2) When do I pay for ROCORI Kid Care?**

A: With this program, payments will be automatically deducted from your bank account or credit card. Payments will be taken out either the first Wednesday of every month or every Wednesday, depending on your personal preference. If you choose not to use the automatic withdrawal system, you may pay by check or cash by the first Wednesday of every month, or every Wednesday, depending on your personal preference.

### **3) Will my child get breakfast and snack every day?**

A: A light breakfast will be served every morning from 7:15-7:45a.m. We encourage students to eat a small breakfast before coming to Kid Care, as a complete breakfast will not be served. A snack will also be served during the day. Each family is responsible for supplying a monthly classroom snack. The Kid Care provider will send reminders and communicate any allergies.

### **4) Do we still pay for days that students don't attend?**

Yes.

### **5) Where can I look for notes, permission slips, etc.?**

A: Each family will have a mailbox. Please check your mailbox every day! If you are not sure where to find your mailbox, ask a staff member and we will show you.

### **6) Can my child(ren) bring toys from home?**

A: To avoid distractions and conflicts with toys, we ask that your child(ren) do not bring toys from home. Students who participate in rest time will be allowed to bring a small stuffed animal that they may take out only during rest time.

### **7) What should I leave at Kid Care?**

Tennis shoes – required outside and in gym

Book to read during quiet time

Extra clothes

Water bottle (with name)

Sunscreen – please check supply level each week.

Blanket/stuffed toy – for students entering who will have a “rest” time.
