121 FIELD TRIPS AND CLASS TRIPS

The Board authorizes field trips and class trips as set forth in this Policy and its accompanying Regulation. A "field trip" shall mean a group excursion for a first-hand observation related to some topic or issue which students are studying and which is included in the curriculum.

A "class trip" is a group trip supervised by certificated school employees scheduled as a culminating activity at the discretion of the principal. Although desirable, it is recognized that this type of trip may not bear a direct relationship to the instructional program.

Field trips shall be provided for students as specified in the approved courses of study or as approved by the Superintendent or designee.

Chaperones and students shall adhere to all District and school policies and regulations during the course of field trips and class trips as if they are on school property.

The Superintendent shall prepare regulations which shall govern field trips for students.
