**115 CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION**

The Board recognizes that the educational needs of various students are met through a program of career and technical education. Therefore, a program of career and technical education shall be provided which shall include:

1. The enrollment of students in a shared-time program of career and technical education outside of the District, provided that such program is not offered in the District and provided that such enrollment has been approved by the parent or guardian of the student.
2. A work-study program for the employment of qualified students.
3. A general field experience program to orient students to the nature of certain occupations.

Definitions

“Career and technical education” means any form of education of less than college grade given in school or elsewhere, the purpose of which is to fit an individual to pursue effectively a recognized profitable employment, whether pursued for wages or otherwise.

Delegation of Responsibility

Consistent with Administrative Regulation No. 115, “Career and Technical Education,” the Board shall maintain, and the Superintendent shall prepare procedures for, career and technical education programs.
