### 445 SUPPLEMENTAL PAY POSITIONS - COACHING

## I. Selection of Coaches

- A. Every effort shall be made by the school principals to fill coaching positions by teachers within their schools.
- B. If that is not possible, consideration may be given to teachers from other schools. However, before a coaching position can be offered to a teacher in another school, the Superintendent, or his designee, shall review the matter in order to determine that the assignment is in the best interest of the School District.
- C. If teachers within the School District are not interested in a particular position, the principal shall seek to employ a person other than a teacher within the School District.

## II. Guidelines Concerning Released Time for Coaches

- A. Teachers are required to meet their contractual obligations of a seven-hour work day.
- B. High school principals should make every effort to schedule away athletic contests for 3:30 p.m., particularly for those sports coached by middle and elementary school teachers.
- C. Middle school teachers who coach at either high school or the other middle school may leave their middle school assignments early with prior approval of the principal, <u>for away</u> games only.
- D. Middle school teachers who coach at either high school or the other middle school may leave their middle school assignments at 2:50 p.m. daily for practices and home athletic contests.
- E. Elementary school teachers who coach at the high schools or the middle schools may leave their elementary school assignments early with prior approval of the principal, <u>for away games only</u>.
- F. Elementary school teachers who coach at the high schools may leave their elementary school assignments early, with prior approval of the principal, for practices and home athletic contests.
- G. Except for the regularly scheduled contests, coaches may not be released from their regular teaching assignments to coach a sport or to conduct practices within their own school, unless prior approval has been granted by the Superintendent or his designee.
