443 USE OF VOLUNTEER AIDES

I. Introduction

Education is a complex process which often requires the individualization of instruction. One way to meet the individualization requirement is to make use of volunteer aides in the schools. A volunteer aide is any person who serves in the schools without compensation, including but not limited to, parents, students, and other citizens of the community.

II. Guidelines

- 1. General instructions should be given to volunteer aides as a group by the principal or his or her designee.
- 2. The teacher or person with whom the volunteer aide is to serve should offer specific directions on an individual basis.
- 3. The teacher is always responsible for the education of the pupils in his or her charge.
- 4. Access to confidential materials, such as cumulative records, health records, report cards, etc., is limited to the professional staff.
- 5. Volunteer aides are expected to adhere to school district policies, guidelines and regulations.
- 6. Volunteer aides are protected by school district liability insurance to the same extent as are paid employees.
