

Hudson Montessori School is currently seeking a part-time Children's House (Ages 3-6) Physical Education Teacher for the 2018-2019 school year.

This position will be one or two mornings a week starting in late August 2018. Currently the days of class are Monday and Thursday. A final schedule will be determined through the interview process.

Children's House weekly physical education classes strengthen a child's balance, hand-eye coordination, tactile awareness, directionality and agility. Cooperative games strengthen the classroom community and encourage the spirit of good sportsmanship. Responsibilities center on overseeing the overall development of all students in Children's House. Each class section meets once per week for 30 minutes. The teacher creates a curriculum to meet the goals of the class. In addition, kindness, sportsmanship and elements of team play are emphasized. The instructor communicates with Lead Teachers about opportunities for Physical Education class to better develop mind and body.

Prior experience with children ages 3-6 and with physical education instruction is preferred.
