Dear Student:

You have registered for the AP Preparatory PreCalculus course at Woodinville High School for the next school year. This course is the first course in our two-year AP mathematics program at WHS. The AP Prep PreCalculus course includes additional content compared to our PreCalculus course. The AP Prep PreCalculus course provides the best preparation for the AP Calculus course offered at WHS. It is expected that students who enter the AP Prep PreCalculus course are ready to extend their work from the Algebra 2 Trig course.

In order to help you assess your readiness for the AP Prep PreCalculus course in the fall, you will take three online progress checks. You can access these progress checks from a WAMAP (Washington Mathematics Assessment and Placement) class website. Instructions on how to register for this class are given on the back of this letter. Your AP Prep PreCalculus teacher will have access to your scores in the fall to determine whether you have successfully completed these online assessments. The assessments must be completed by September 21, 2018.

You will be able to complete these online progress checks over multiple sessions. As you work on the online assessments, you may find that you need some review before you can complete an assessment. The appendix from the PreCalculus: Graphs and Models textbook that is used in the AP Prep PreCalculus course will be available on the WAMAP site. You will also find an outline with suggested problems to practice for the different sections in the appendix along with links to videos going over some of the exercises. You may find for some sections that you do not need to do all of the suggested practice problems and for other sections that you may need to do some additional problems. Your AP Prep teacher will not be collecting this practice work; it is intended only to help you prepare for the online assessments.

I encourage you to set a schedule for completing this work over the summer. You will find this work to be more enjoyable if you do not wait until the last minute to try to do it. The WHS math department looks forward to working with you in the fall. Let me know if you have any questions.

## Registering for the AP Prep PreCalculus Summer Practice WAMAP course

### I. Already Registered with WAMAP

- 3) Select Enroll in a Course

### II. New to WAMAP

- 2) Select Register as a New Student
- 3) Submit a User Name and Password – these are unique to you
- 4) Enter your first name, last name, and email address
