Dear Student:

You have registered for the Algebra 2 Trigonometry course at Woodinville High School for the next school year. This course is intended to prepare students for the AP Preparatory PreCalculus course at WHS. The Algebra 2 Trigonometry course includes additional content compared to our Algebra 2 course. The Algebra 2 Trigonometry course prepares students for the AP math sequence at WHS. It is expected that students who enter the Algebra 2 Trigonometry course are ready to extend their work from both the Algebra 1 and Geometry courses.

In order to help you assess your readiness for the Algebra 2 Trigonometry course in the fall, you will take three online progress checks. You can access these progress checks from a WAMAP (Washington Mathematics Assessment and Placement) class website. Instructions on how to register for this class are given on the back of this letter. Your Algebra 2 Trigonometry teacher will have access to your scores in the fall in order to determine whether you have successfully completed these online assessments. The assessments must be completed by September 21, 2018.

You will be able to complete these online progress checks over multiple sessions. As you work on the online assessments, you may find that you need some review before you can complete an assessment. A set of handouts from the Prentice Hall resource materials is available in the course on the WAMAP website. You will also find an outline with suggested problems to practice for each handout. You may find that for some topics that you do not need to do all of the suggested practice problems, and for other topics that you may need to do some additional problems. Your Algebra 2 Trigonometry teacher will not be collecting this practice work; it is intended only to help you prepare for the online assessments.

I encourage you to set a schedule for completing this work over the summer. The WHS math department looks forward to working with you in the fall. Let me know if you have any questions.
