

## Community Council Notes from 10/11/17

- Our sixth grade came in 2<sup>nd</sup> in the district for typing; fifth grade came in 1<sup>st</sup>
- We have \$38,000 in Trustlands money this year. There is \$1,000 that is still unspent.
  - With the surplus of money we will upgrade projectors in the classrooms. Mr. Hammer will write a grant that matches money from Trustlands and from the PTA. This will be a total of \$10,000 to be used for field trips and projectors.
- A motion was made to approve using the surplus Trustlands money for projectors. It was approved.
- Goals for the year were reviewed, as well as how those goals will be met.
- We now have just under 40 students in steam club.
- We continue to increase rigor by sending teacher to RCA and implementing the practices seen there.
- We are implementing Tiger Town University this year. The students will be able to research topics they are interested in and receive degrees based on the amount of research time put in. Awards will be given during Spirit Assemblies.
