



Immunization Requirements

7th Grade Entry 2018-2019

To attend the 7th grade, a student must have written proof of receiving the following immunizations:

- Tdap
- 2 measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR)
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 Varicella (chickenpox)
- 1 Meningococcal (Only Meningococcal vaccine given after 10 years of age is acceptable for 7th grade school entry)
- 4 Polio (3 doses, if 3rd dose was given on/after the 4th birthday)
- 2 Hepatitis A
- 5 DTaP/DT (4 doses of DTaP, if 4th dose given on/after 4th birthday; 3 doses of Td, if starting series after age 7 years with a single dose of Tdap preferred as the first dose).

Starting July 1, 2018 (Utah House Bill 308)

Proof of immunity to disease(s), including chickenpox, can be accepted in place of vaccination only if a document from a health care provider states the student previously contracted the disease. Present health care provider documentation to the school office.

Parent/guardians who have students/children claiming exemption for required immunizations, must provide a **new exemption form when entering 7th grade**. Exemption forms can be obtained by completing a free on-line educational module at www.immunize-utah.org. At the completion of the module print the exemption form and take to the school office.
