

Lakeland Virtual Academy Special Education Procedures

Regular Classroom Teacher Responsibilities

Teachers will:

1. Attend and participate in IEP meetings.
2. Provide the appropriate services as outlined on the IEP.
3. Receive a copy of the student's IEP.
4. Contact the special education teacher with questions or comments as needed.

Special Education Teacher Responsibilities and Related Service Providers

Special education teachers and related service providers will:

1. Contact the regular classroom teacher on an "as needed" basis to provide him/her with information that may be valuable in the virtual classroom.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

1. If the student's IEP requires related services such as speech therapy, occupational therapy, counseling, etc., the parent/guardian is responsible for scheduling sessions and transporting the student to the site where services can be provided.
2. Parents/guardians are required to transport their student to the designated District facility at the appointed time for participation in state mandated test administrations (IRI, ISAT, DWA, DMA, IAA, IELA, NAEP, etc.).
