

Principal Of The Lakeland Virtual Academy

The principal of the Lakeland Virtual Academy has, under the direction of the Board of Trustees and Superintendent/ designee, general supervision of the school, its academic program, and its personnel.

Guidelines

1. The principal should:
 - a. provide leadership in keeping abreast of current educational developments, especially as they relate to virtual teaching, learning, and best practices;
 - b. arrange for staff development necessary to establish, operate, and manage learning programs that meet more learner needs;
 - c. coordinate cooperative efforts with the District and any providers (e.g. K12[®] Inc.) Inc. to improve learning programs, testing facilities, equipment, and curriculum materials.
 - d. develop and maintain close working relationships and open channels of communication within the school and the communities served.
 - e. encourage a proactive problem solving approach within the school.
2. The principal at his/her discretion may delegate to other school personnel the exercise of any powers and the discharge of any duties.
3. The delegation of power or duty, however, will not relieve the principal of ultimate responsibility for actions taken under such delegation.
