


Instructions for Accessing 2nd – 6th Math Guardian





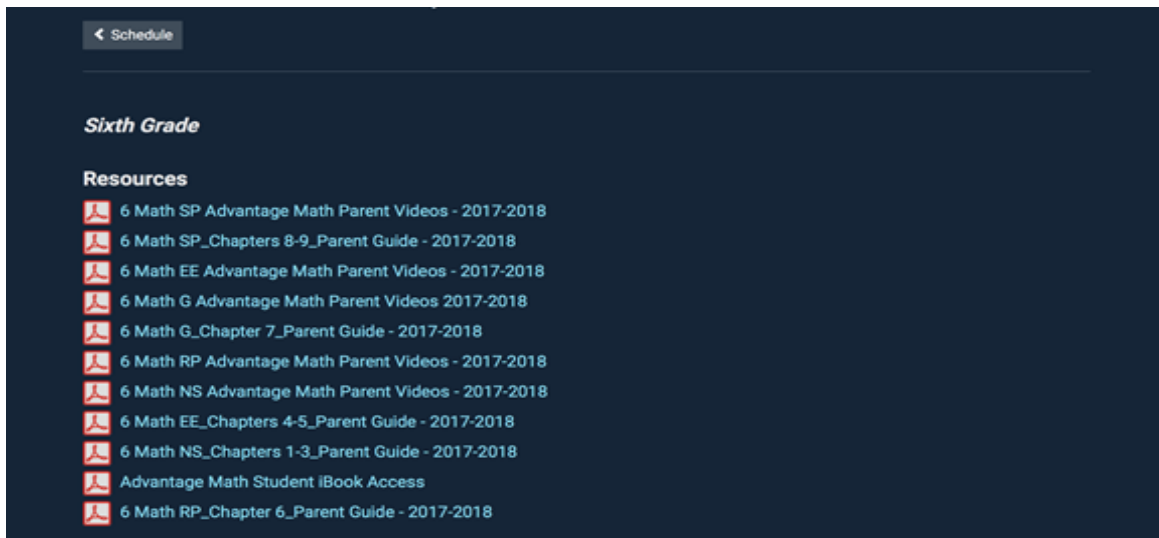
