

## Centerville Elementary School Traffic Plan

Below you will find important information about traffic safety. It is important that all parents take traffic safety very seriously and drive in a safe and responsible manner near the school.


Thanks for keeping our children safe!

It is very important that all families follow the school traffic safety rules around the school. We have noticed a few unacceptable traffic practices at our school. Please be aware of the following points:

1. The parking lot on the North side of the building is reserved for parking only. Please pick-up / drop-off along one of the following three areas:

You can stop at the back of the school near the playground on 200 East, near the front of the school on 100 East, or along Parrish Lane. In the morning, please drop off your child(ren) at one of these locations, then safely and quickly move out of the way. In the afternoon, please have your child(ren) quickly proceed to the appropriate location so you can pick them up and move off safely and quickly.

2. We do not want to endanger any students, so we ask that you follow the school traffic-pattern shown below. Traffic moves in a clockwise direction only around the school. When driving in your car, make sure that the school is always on your right side.



Avoid parking on the West side of 100 East, the East side of 200 East, or the North side of Parrish Lane. Parents jay-walking or beckoning to their children to run across the street is an unsafe practice.

3. Keep an eye out for children walking or riding their bicycles to and from school and for cars pulling in and out of traffic both before and after school.
4. Pay attention to school zones by slowing down. If you are found going over the speed limit in an active school zone, you will pay a minimum of \$82 for a ticket.

## WALKING TO SCHOOL

Most of the students attending Centerville Elementary will be walking to school. Please be aware of these students as you are driving your child to and from school. Parents of these students should help them select a safe, regular route to use to and from school. Sidewalks are stationed around the school and should be used wherever possible. Do not permit your child to cross mid-block or between parked cars. Remind your child to use the crosswalks and crossing guards. They are there for your child's safety.

## PEDESTRIAN SAFETY

1. When riding skateboards or bicycles to school, please be careful. Stay on sidewalks or the side of the road. Riding in the street has caused a number of near-misses. Remember to give the right-of-way to pedestrians and watch extra carefully as approaching driveways.
2. Students need to walk on the sidewalk or the grass when no sidewalk is available. People driving on the road are sometimes distracted and that's when accidents happen.

We hope that these procedures will contribute to a safe environment for our students as they come to and leave school. We ask your cooperation in helping to make all students as safe as possible by abiding by these procedures.
