104 SCHOOL DISTRICT MISSION AND VISION STATEMENTS

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a clear statement of the purpose for which the school district exists.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

The school board believes that mission and vision statements should be adopted and reviewed at a minimum of every five years in conjunction with the school district's goal setting process. The mission and vision statements should be based on the beliefs and values of the community, should direct any change effort and should be the basis on which decisions are made. The school board, on behalf of and with participation by the community, should develop the mission and vision for the school district regarding the nature of the enterprise the school board governs, the purposes it serves, the constituencies it should consider, and the results it intends to produce.
