

POLICY 546 - EARLY ADMISSION TO KINDERGARTEN

EARLY ADMISSION PROCEDURES

1. Secure an application form from the Central Registration Office. Complete and return the application to the Central Registration Office by no later than April 15.
2. Children who turn five (5) before October 15th may be considered for early admission. A certified birth certificate is required to take an application.
3. The child must be evaluated by a licensed school psychologist at the parents' expense. The evaluation must include assessment of the following areas:
 - a. Cognitive Ability
 - b. Social/Emotional Skills
 - c. Academic Skills
 - d. Parent Observations
 - e. District Educator Observations
4. Only those children whose performance is at or above the 95%ile in all of the above areas will be considered for early admission.
5. If the child meets the above criteria, a formal staffing will be held to discuss probationary placement in the kindergarten program.
6. Evaluation of the probationary kindergarten placement is to be made before fall conferences.
7. The school reserves the right to make the final placement decision.
