618 STUDENT EVALUATION AND GRADING

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to establish a system of student evaluation and grading.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

It will be the policy of the school district to report student progress for elementary students to their parents by scheduling conferences at various times during the school year. It is the policy to have no letter grades permanently recorded in the elementary schools. At the end of the year a card is sent home declaring promotion status for the following year.

In the middle and senior high schools the policy is to use an A, B, C, D, and F grading system. Variations from the five-letter system, such as A+, A-, C+, C-, are permitted.

Numerical values of grades at the senior high school level in the District are as follows:

	A = 4.0	A- = 3.67
B+ = 3.33	B = 3.0	B- = 2.67
C+ = 2.33	C = 2.0	C- = 1.67
D+ = 1.33	D = 1.0	D- = .67
	F = 0	

Advanced Placement Classes (weighted classes) follow the above scale with 1 point added (i.e., A- would equal 4.67).
